Residents meeting the following criteria will be eligible to receive a new smoke alarm:

- Live in the City of Tyler, Texas; and,
- Own and occupy their home.

“While the primary goal of this campaign is to install smoke alarms in homes that don’t already have them, we also hope to educate homeowners and residents on the importance of maintaining these devices,” explained Tyler Fire Marshal Paul Findley. “As part of this program, the Fire Department hopes to raise awareness and increase the number of these life-saving devices in our community.”

This program is part of the Tyler Fire Department’s overall effort to highlight the importance of fire safety and prevention.
